

Mata lives near the ocean in the Trobriand Islands. When he was young, he learned how to make things out of wood. Now he can make a variety of things.




Dopale mende itame wasoo pituu, baame ita dokonya pikisa wasingi. Pikisa wasepae dupame atome mendapu latae katenge.

Then he cut up some seashells and glued the pieces onto the large bowl.




Dopa petala, baame itame wasepae disa andake dokonya kala pumbuti doko katasia.
